Big Plans comes in free and will assess your child at preschool if they are eligible to attend Kindergarten the following school year. Any child can be assisted and any issue can be caught early! Most often, your child will outgrow what issues might come to light, but why not take advantage of the free service by caring professionals? They are trained to check for Physical development (fine and gross motor), Social skills, behaviour, Language and Thinking as well as Communication.
